

TREE SURVEY PROTOCOL

- Note the scale used on the survey (i.e. 1" = 50') and the direction of North.
- Show dimensions of parcel.
- Show only existing structures on the plan.
- All Trees 8" DBH (Diameter at Breast Height) or larger must be depicted on the survey.
- Include a list of all trees 8" DBH or larger on the site with their corresponding tree identifying number and a disposition (save or remove). Indicate species (common name), size and condition.
- Trees which are to be removed must be marked in the field (ribbon, paint) and inspected prior to any removal.
- Include a table indicating:
 - total number of trees on site
 - total number of trees to be removed
 - total number of replacement trees required to be planted on site
- If existing trees are to be relocated, show the proposed location for such trees, together with a statement as to how such trees are to be protected and/or stored during land clearance and construction and how they are to be maintained after construction.

To show graphically the trees to be removed, to remain or to be relocated. The following symbols are suggested:
